2022 SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

Eligibility

1. The Cecil Harford USBC Association Senior Singles Championship Tournament is open to all USBC certified members of the CHUSBC Association.
2. All entrants must be at least 50 years of age. Entrants will be placed in divisions according to their age as of the date of participation. Separate divisions for men and women.
3. Entrants who are not a member of the CHUSBC can purchase a co-association membership for \$8.00 by the closing date of the tournament.

Format

4. Participants will bowl 4 games moving after 2 games. Total of all 4 games plus handicap will determine the winner.
5. If a tie exists for the championship of a division, co-champions shall be declared. For purposes of determining advancement to the Maryland State USBC Association State Seniors Championship, the player with the highest scratch game will advance. If a tie still exists, the second highest scratch game will be used, etc.

Average Requirements/ Handicap

6. Entrant shall use their highest certified average established in any USBC certified league from the previous season (winter & summer) 2020-2021 based on 21 games or more.
7. If an entrant has no previous season (2020-2021) yearbook certified USBC average, they must use their highest current season's USBC certified average for 12 games or more from any Association per USBC Rule 319a-1. In addition, entrant must furnish a league standing sheet with written verification from their league secretary as of the closing date of the tournament.
8. If eligibility requirements are met and bowler doesn't meet the average requirement they must bowl scratch.

9. Rule 319A, Item 2 (ten pin up rule) is not in effect.
10. Handicap will be 90% of 220 with no maximum handicap.

Prizes & Awards

11. The HANDICAP winners in each Division (A++, A+, A, B, C, D and E) will receive a paid entry into the Maryland State Senior Championship Tournament. The scratch winner in each Division will receive the title only.
12. All prize fees collected in a division will be returned 100% to the participants in that division. Prize fund will be paid at a ratio of at least 1:8 handicap.

Miscellaneous

13. USBC rule 319d (prize winnings), and 319e (re-rating) will apply.
14. Entrants must present their current USBC membership card at the time of check in.
15. Entry fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Tournament Manager.
16. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for checks returned by the bank for non-payment.
17. **PARTICIPANTS MAY ENTER ONLY ONE TIME.**
18. Any protests must comply with USBC rule 329.
19. Errors in scoring must be reported within 48 hours.
