# TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All 2021 /2022 USBC youth members are eligible to participate in the Cecil Harford USBC Association Youth Championship Tournament. USBC Youth Tournament Rules will apply at all times.
2. Handicap shall be 90% of 200 – All Divisions. Use highest current average as of January 24, 2022 (If a bowler does not have the required number of games (9) by the entry deadline, their average as of Jan. 24<sup>th</sup> may be used.) unless yearbook average is higher, with at least six games as a Bantam, or at least nine games as a Prep, Junior, or Major/Senior, in a current season, or bowl scratch: in that order. The Association Manager and/or Tournament Committee will verify averages by CHUSBC Youth Yearbook and/or Center Standing Sheets. Summer averages can be used if a bowler is not bowling in a fall league.
3. Divisions will be determined by average. (Boys & Girls combined)

(Any division having less than six entries will be combined with the next highest division (except Div. A). A master list showing divisions and prizes will be posted at the tournament site prior to bowling).
4. **Multiple Entries:** Entrants may bowl multiple times in Team Event provided two members are changed. Entrants may bowl multiple times in the Doubles Event but not with the same partner. Entrants may bowl in the Singles Event only once. First scores count for All Events.
5. All bowlers will bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes in each event entered.
6. Clearly indicate first and second choices for squad date and time for each event entered.
7. **All entrants must report to the Tournament Registration desk at least 30 minutes prior to bowling.** Bowlers should bring their sanction cards to check-in; tardy bowlers will receive a zero for frames missed. Absolutely no refunds for absent bowlers.
8. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to correct any mistakes in average, division, handicap, or totals at any time prior to the presentation of awards.
9. Any appeal or protest regarding scores and/or eligibility must be made to the Tournament Committee within 24 hours of dispute. A foul must be reported immediately.
10. Awards will be based on a 1 in 5 ratio in each division with minimum awards of 1 & 2 in each division. All awards will be handicap. Award fees will be returned 100%.
  - **Special scratch prizes** will be awarded from the CHUSBC general fund. They will be awarded by USBC age divisions and gender: (Bantam boys, Bantam girls, Prep boys, Prep girls, junior boys, junior girls, Major/Senior boys, Major/Senior girls) for: 1- High All Events (9 games); 2- High Series (3 games, any event); 3- High Game (any event). Bowler receives the first of these qualified for and no bowler may receive more than one scratch prize. In case of a tie, duplicate awards will be presented.
11. **An optional All-Events Scratch and Handicap Scholarship event will be run using the entrant's first Singles, Doubles, and Team scores. This event is gender based with no age divisions. The additional cost per entry is \$5.00 for each. (you can enter into both) Pay 1 in 10 with \$100.00 maximum prize.** Winnings will be deposited in Smart Account - #12729
12. Conduct-& Dress Code: **Conduct** - No participant will be permitted to use electronic devices (cell phones, video games, etc.) use tobacco products, illegal drugs, use profanity, or drink alcoholic beverages while involved in tournament play. (USBC Rule 17d, Youth Conduct) Lane courtesy is to be practiced at all times. **Dress Code** – Presentable attire is expected. No hats, cut-offs or clothing with rips, tears, holes, or inappropriate language shall be worn during competition.
