

Bryan Michael Lindecamp

Superior Performance



Bryan Thomas Lindecamp was born on June 19, 1980 to Mike and Sandy Lindecamp. He graduated from Aberdeen Senior High School in 1998. In 2017, Bryan married Kendall Burchard and they have two sons, Ethan and Camden.

Bryan began bowling in the youth program at Harford Lanes in 1986 at the age of 6, with his friends Jimmy Cassady, Adam Barnard, Bryan Spies and Kevin Walker. In Middle School, at the age of 12, Bryan threw a career high single with a 255 and his best three-game series of 669. His average at that time was 160.

Some of his most memorable youth accomplishments began in 1991 where he, along with teammates Kevin Walker, Adam Barnard and Jimmy Cassady won the Cecil-Harford scratch team event with a score of 1890. As a Jr bowler his accomplishments were winning the 1998 Maryland State Coca-Cola Youth Bowling Championship which qualified him to participate in the international bowling tournament held in Houston, Texas. Also 1998, at the age of 17, Bryan bowled his first perfect “300” game. Ten days later, Bryan bowled another perfect 300.

Bryan credits Bobby Marshall (who was his coach and mentor) and Jack DuBree as being his “bowling idols”. While his Mom was bowling on the Women’s scratch league on Friday night alongside of the Men’s scratch league, Bryan would go with her to watch these two men bowl every week so he could gain some tips. After the leagues were done bowling for the night, Bobby would let the youth bowl until it was time to leave.

Bryan joined adult leagues in 199 at the age of 17 with a high book average of 211. He bowled his first 300 in 1998 in the Bill Snavelly league, his first 800 on May 22, 2022. Brian’s most memorable moment had to be on January 19th, 2007, when along with teammates Tim Moor, Kevin Walker, Rob Hunter and John Vananzo, collectively known as “Ray’s Boom Boom Room” started the 3rd game of the Bill Snavelly league with the first 42 strikes, a USBC record. It resulted in a 1399 team game, the highest in the USBC for the 06-07 season and at the time was the 4th highest game of all time.

In 2016, Bryan bowled in a Monday night men's league at the Bowlerama in Delaware and ranked 2nd with 7208 pins, 30 games, and a 240.27 average. He came back the following year at the same location and finished 2nd once again with statistics of 16566 pins, 69 games, and an average of 240.09.

Bryan has competed in more than 55 USBC National Tournament. Along with this, Bryan has received several cash prizes in PBA regional events.
